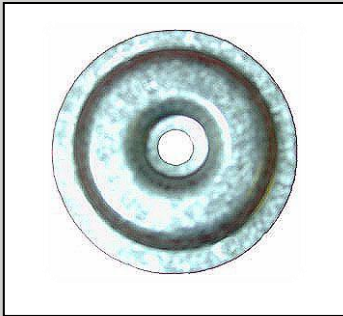

Description

The 2" (51 mm) Metal Plates are specifically designed to be used with Elevate All-Purpose, Heavy Duty (HD) and Concrete Drive Fasteners in roofing system applications, for the attachment of Elevate roof membranes and Reinforced Perimeter Fastening (RPF) Strips as permitted by current Elevate specifications and details.

Method of Application

1. Position the 2" (51 mm) Metal Plates as permitted by current Elevate specifications and details.
2. Attach plates with the appropriate Elevate fastener with the ribbed side up, showing the Elevate label.

Storage

Store in unopened original containers protected for the weather.

Precautions

- Do not overdrive or underdrive fastener.
- Not for use with Heavy Duty Plus Fasteners.
- Avoid installing HD Seam Plates / field seams directly over insulation plates.
