

# Installing StoGuard® is easy!

StoGuard, a fluid-applied waterproof air barrier membrane is not only easy to install properly but is also affordable. Install StoGuard in 3 quick, easy steps!

# Step 1

1. Apply Sto EmeraldCoat® by spray or roller liberally to all vertical and horizontal sheathing joints.

Embed 4"(400 mm) StoGuard Fabric.

# Step 2



2. Apply Sto EmeraldCoat® over the StoGuard Fabric.

# Step 3



3. Apply Sto EmeraldCoat® onto the entire wall surface. Sto EmeraldCoat® can be used beneath various claddings.

# Window Openings and Similar **Rough Opening Protection**

### StoGuard® RediCorner™

### Step 1

1. Spray (or roll) corner liberally with Sto EmeraldCoat®.

### Step 2



2. Place StoGuard RediCorner with tabs out into the corner.

### Step 3



3. Roll Sto EmeraldCoat® over StoGuard RediCorner. Complete all four corners.

Note: As an alternative to StoGuard RediCorner, StoGuard Fabric tabs may be installed at corners.

# StoGuard® Fabric

### Step 1



1. Roll or spray entire rough window opening liberally with Sto EmeraldCoat®.

## Step 2



2. Embed fabric into Sto EmeraldCoat®. Be sure it overlaps the StoGuard RediCorner by two inches (50 mm) minimum.

3. Complete all four sides of the rough opening.
