## **Xypex Contributes to the LEED Credits**

### *Materials and Resources*

#### **MR Credit 2.1**

##### **Construction Waste Management**

Divert construction, demolition and land-clearing debris from disposal in landfills and incinerators. Redirect recyclable recovered resources back to the manufacturing process. Xypex packaging is 100% recyclable and can therefore be included in the Waste Management Plan under recyclables.

#### **MR Credit 5.1**

##### **Regional Materials 10% (up to 20%) Extracted, Processed & Manufactured Regionally (1 or 2 Point(s))**

Increase demand for building materials and products that are extracted and manufactured within 500 miles of the project, thereby supporting the use of indigenous resources and reducing the environmental impacts resulting from transportation. Xypex products are manufactured in Richmond, BC, Canada.

### *Indoor Environmental Quality*

#### **EQ Credit 4.2**

##### **Low Emitting Materials Paints and Coatings (1 Point)**

Reduce the quantity of indoor air contaminants that are odorous, irritating and/or harmful to the comfort and well being of installers and occupants. Xypex products contain zero VOCs.
